## MARMOT BASIN – YOUR NEXT SKI DESTINATION

Located in the breathtaking, vast and ruggedly mountainous landscape of Jasper National Park in the Canadian Rocky Mountains, Marmot Basin is a destination that inspires lasting memories.

### NEW TERRAIN, NEW QUAD CHAIR

With the addition of new chairlifts, new terrain, and countless renovations to facilities, Marmot Basin is a world-class ski area within Canada's largest Rocky Mountain national park.

New for the 2023-24 season is the Knob Quad chairlift that reaches into the highest alpine regions of the mountain providing access to huge, above tree-line bowls and chutes including the newly opened Marmot Cirque terrain.

The new chairlift takes skiers and boarders to an unload elevation of 8,238 feet (2,511 metres) with a vertical drop of 1,260 feet (384 vertical metres) providing lift access to more terrain than ever before. The new chair rises 331 vertical feet (101 vertical metres) above the Knob double chair it replaces.

### MORE TO DISCOVER

Get off the beaten-path and discover a "Hidden Gem" this season. Situated in the largest Canadian Rockies National Park, Marmot Basin offers world class amenities deep within pristine wilderness. Picture breathtaking scenery, champagne powder filled bowls and chutes, wide open groomers and exquisite gladed runs. All of this without lift lines, huge price tags or pretentiousness. This is the real Canadian Rockies, where the wildlife roam the streets and the locals greet you with smiles and stories of epic adventures. We're not without our creature comforts however; with superb dining and accommodation options. From your own cabin with a roaring fire, to sophisticated and modern hotels, Jasper has something for every taste.

### WHY MARMOT BASIN?

**FANTASTIC SNOW** Marmot Basin is the northernmost Rocky Mountain ski area and enjoys abundant dry, light & fluffy snow that is a dream to ski and snowboard. With the highest base elevation in Canada and a latitude of 53°N, over 4.5 meters of natural snow blankets the area from November through May. Combined with a state-of-the-art snowmaking system that guarantees snow surety; skiers and snowboarders enjoy superb snow conditions all season long!

**DIVERSE TERRAIN** Skiers and snowboarders can explore a wide variety of runs, from novice to expert, on five mountain faces. You will uncover long, perfectly groomed trails, high alpine bowls, treed runs, and steep chutes filled with Rocky Mountain powder snow. With 1,720 acres (696 hectares) of skiable terrain and seven modern lifts, the only time to rest is in the lodge, not waiting in lines.

**BREATHTAKING SCENERY** Virtually every location on the mountain is an inspirational viewpoint. Jasper National Park, Canada's largest Rocky Mountain park, is an integral part of the UNESCO Canadian Rockies World Heritage Site. You are surrounded by protected wilderness in every direction. Memories will be etched as highlights in your life as you experience the only ski destination in this unparalleled paradise.

**JASPER, WILDLIFE AND ACTIVITIES** Venture beyond the crowds this winter to the authentic Canadian, mountain town of Jasper. Mix with the locals who are quick with a smile and a tale or two as they share their slice of heaven with visitors. Enjoy Canadian and international cuisine and a lively night scene while staying in quaint inns or luxurious lodges.

## GETTING TO JASPER

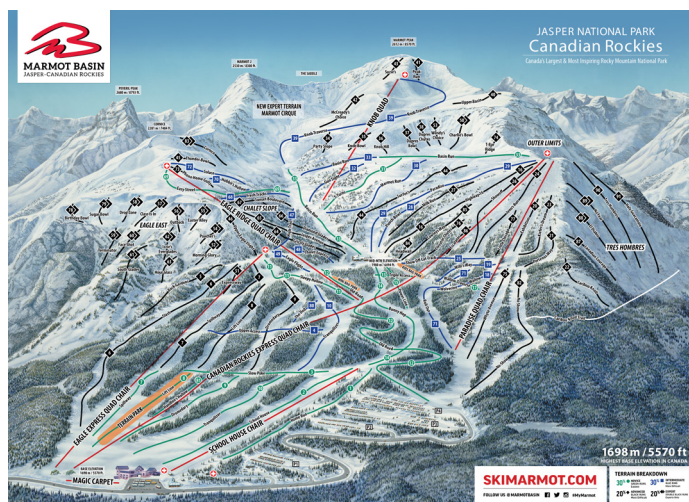
Marmot Basin is located 20 km south of the town of Jasper. It is only a 3 ¾ hour trip from Edmonton to Jasper on the 16 Yellowhead Highway. From Calgary take the scenic 4 ½ hour drive along the 93 Icefields Parkway.

**AIR ACCESS** Edmonton and Calgary are the primary gateways to the Canadian Rockies. These international airports provide non-stop direct flights from major cities in Canada, the United States, Europe and Asia-Pacific.
